Subject:- Spreading of Viral fever including chikungunya and dengue in the Amrapali Village Residential Society, Indirapuram (Ghaziabad).

Sir,

We would like to draw your immediate attention to the alarming growing cases of viral fever including chikungunya and dengue in the Amrapali Village Residential Society, Indirapuram (Ghaziabad) badly affecting majority of the residents. Our society consists of more than 1000 flats having occupancy of more than 4000 residents.

- 2. <u>During the last few months, it has been observed that more than 1000 residents got infected to viral fever including chikungunya, malaria and dengue owing to very poor sanitary conditions of our society and also the nearby surroundings. The adjoining areas of society especially near the society entrance gates are always full of heaps of dirt and litter scattered everywhere. The Government sweeper hardly bothers to sweep the area regularly. BOTH Drains one within the society and another touching the society main entrances are open and completely choked because of non cleaning on regular basis. All these provides a breeding ground for the spread of mosquitoes and other germs and hence lead to the outbreak of chikungunya, malaria and dengue diseases in our society affecting very severely thousands of our society senior citizens, small kids and ladies. The society premises have turned into a small hell. There is foul smell all around coming within the society premises due to the rubbish and dirty drains and a big dump yard touching the society premises.</u>
- 3. We sincerely and very humbly request you to kindly pay your personal attention to the deteriorating health condition of our society's residents owing to the poor sanitary conditions for reasons mentioned above and request you to take the following immediate steps:
 - a. Kindly nominate a Senior Health officer along with team on priority basis to personally visit our society premises for inspecting and verifying the deteriorating sanitation condition of our society and surrounding around it.
 - b. Identify the critical areas which need to be targeted for stopping the further spread of deadly viral fever in the society affecting thousands of society residents.
 - c. Take necessary actions which are necessary to improve the insanitary conditions both within and outside the society premises. Kindly Instruct your team for carrying out preventive measures within the society premises like intense Fogging and spreading of mosquito repellant powder and spread of kerosene oil on the stagnant water inside and outside the society premises.
